



Sledding Protocols - 2021-22 - November 22, 2021

Please remember that sledding during the school day is a privilege!

The following protocols may change through the winter and the hill may be shut down at times, depending on weather conditions, or for particular students who are not following the rules.

1. All sledding will be on the south end of the upper field to the west of the power pole. Signs will be used daily to communicate which areas on the south slope are open at that time, as conditions can change quickly from day to day.
2. Signs will also show where riders are to climb back up the slope to ride again. Once a sled gets to the bottom, riders must get out of the way of the next sledders and only climb up in these areas.
3. There is a maximum of 2 people per sled, no standing on sleds, no chains of sleds, no pushing, and no riding backwards.
4. Sledders must stop before getting to the soccer field area.
5. At this time, sliding without sleds is allowed in other areas on the upper field only and not in other areas, including not on the slope right behind the school.
6. The zone at the southwest of the school will be closed during sledding season.
