- Communication of student learning is coming up. We are currently getting guidance from the district about how to do that safely.
- For winter activities, Grades 4-5 will go to Whitewater. For the other grades, we are waiting to see what is available for school groups (Nordic skiing, pool, etc.).
- The snowshoes purchased by PAC have been delivered. They will be ready for teachers to use this winter.

Treasurer's report

 pavilion; \$4,000 earmarked for Shayna Jones; money earmarked for the contractor retainer; \$500 okayed for
 student council holiday fundraiser)
