## Motions

## Principal's report

- Fees for next year are anticipated to be similar to this year. There will be a general fee of $\$ 40$. The activities will vary from $\$ 58-\$ 167$ for downhill skiing, $\$ 21$ for swimming and $\$ 39$ for cross-country skiing. There are always options for families to get support through the school or the PAC.
- The talent show will take place on May 31. It will be by donation. The students are currently deciding where to donate the money.

- The school takes a restorative justice approach to conflict. Families may see follow-up sheets come home about ongoing learning and fixing our mistakes.

## Treasurer's report
