We prepare students to graduate with options for their future life and career goals.



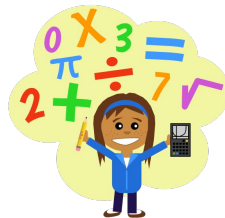

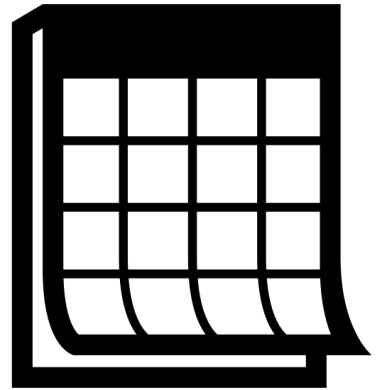
