- Welcome to all the new families.
- Current enrollment is 182 students which encompasses 8 classes (we are full aside from 1 or 2 spots in kindergarten)
- Ms Ward is the new music teacher to South Nelson and Mrs Wilson is back this time as the ADST / Prep teacher
- There are 5 EA's in the school this year
- SD8 Strategic Plan and Code of Conduct (GROWS) overview
- Gotcha cards will be used again to reinforce positive behavior
- Gradual Kindergarten entry is in its first full week (ending at 1Pm this week)
- Cross Country running practices have started (Wed and Fri mornings Sept Oct)

Jessica is the designated Feeding Futures person in the school who will have allocated time every day to have food ready for kids. Breakfast will also be available.
- If you know anyone who needs help with school supply fees, or warm clothes, encourage them to let the school know
- Backpack buddies will continue so food can go home with kids on weekends
- Dream Box last year PAC supported the subscription for 4 classes. This year only 2 classes (Gr 4/5 and 5/6) will use this for math (\$1700-2000 request)
